

PN21 TEAS

- The Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS) score is utilized in the nursing entry process. An adjusted individual total score of 58.7% or greater on the TEAS is required to be considered for admission into the PN Program.
- The student will be allowed three (3) attempts to score the required adjusted individual score of 58.7% or greater on the TEAS exam. It is recommended the student wait a minimum of 30 days between each attempt. In the event that the student does not score the minimum requirement on the TEAS, students should meet with the academic advisor to determine a plan to assist the student to be successful before taking the third attempt.
- TEAS scores will be valid for three (3) calendar years and must not be expired by the deadline for admission for Fall/Spring cohorts.
- The TEAS attempts will apply to the admission criteria of both the practical nursing Certificate and Associate Degree nursing programs. Therefore, the student is allowed three (3) total exam attempts, regardless of program choice.
- Study materials for the TEAS exam are available through Assessment Technologies Institute (ATI) at www.ATItesting.com. It is the student's responsibility to contact the Admissions Office to schedule a time for testing.
